If you test Positive for COVID during Conference

VertiGIS LLC will require attendees and employees to promptly notify our HR Generalist, Casey Daveldek (casey.daveldek@vertigis.com), when they have tested positive for COVID-19 or been diagnosed with COVID-19 by a licensed healthcare provider, have been told by a licensed healthcare provider that they are suspected to have COVID-19, are experiencing recent loss of taste and/or smell with no other explanation, or are experiencing both fever (≥100.4° F) and a new, unexplained cough associated with shortness of breath.

Reporting of Exposure

If VertiGIS LLC is notified of positive test from an attendee or employee, it is our duty to inform all attendees as soon as we have confirmation of a positive COVID test. We will make an announcement to the group and allow attendees/employees to make the decision to continue participating in the conference.
